Back To School Campaign is about providing backpacks filled with essential school supplies for displaced children in Baghdad. The reason why I chose this topic (education) is because it's something that I can relate to as a student it's one of our rights and even though the change that I want to do is not large I can still make a difference.

- 2. Create a donation box in my school to help 50 displaced children by buying them toys from September 2017 to February 2018.what I mean by this is that after we finish the first goal we will make a donation box in my school where students can donate money throughout the first course of the school year which is for like 4 months and after the end of it we will buy with the money toys for the children as a reward so that they can celebrate their holiday with joy.

Project Activities

1) Find a school that is affiliated to an IDPs camp (through my resources I found out that there is an IDPs camp in AI Dora region called kesnzani camp that have a primary school inside it build by UNICEF) I will contact them and ask them if we can distribute school supplies to 50 displaced children who are in the range of 6 to 9 years old. We will ask them if they can gather the kids in the morning in one of the school's classes so that we can come and give the backpacks that are filled with essential school supplies to each kid.



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- 2) Gathering money to buy the school supplies, we will need 530,500 IQD to achieve the first smart goal and like 250,000 IQD to achieve the second smart goal. For the first smart goal We will get the money mostly from the donation of the people surrounding us like from our neighborhoods, Friends and relatives who are willing to donate a good amount of money this process will take about a week may be less (This activity will be done by all of us so that we can get the money fast enough). For the second smart goal we will get the money from the students where they can help make a change themselves it will take mostly three to four months until we reach to the end of the first course (This activity will be done by me because it will happen at my school).
- 3) for the first goal we will go to the school supplies store to buy the needed amount. (Me, Shahlaa and Osamah will take care of this activity) then we will fill the supplies in the backpacks that we also bought (all of us will take care of this mission so that we can get the work to finish faster). For the second goal after we finish the collecting the donation money we (Me, Shahlaa and Osamah) will also go to the toys store and buy the needed amount.
- 4) Implement my campaign of providing school supplies for first grade students in a school that is affiliated to an IDPs camp then after achieving that we will start focusing on our second goal.
